***Bicentennial Moment:*** Bishop Peter Joseph Lavalie died on May 11, 1867, after serving as 3<sup>rd</sup> bishop of the diocese for only 2 years. Lavalie had served the Louisville diocese as a priest since 1844. He was pastor of St. Louis Church and then president of St. Mary's College. During the Civil War he worked in the battlefields dressing wounds and praying with soldiers. The Holy Father twice asked him to be Bishop of Savannah, and he twice refused. He was consecrated as the Bishop of Louisville on September 24, 1865
